- 1. Always stay inside the string boundary unless a leader is with you.
- 2. Always walk in forest school (except for games on the glade).
- 3. No throwing or swinging things around. They may hurt someone.
- 4. Be very careful with sticks.
- 5. Look after all the living things. Never pick growing things.
- 6. Show things you find to the grown ups. They are always interested.
- 7. Wash or wipe your hands before eating. Don't put hands in mouth.
- 8. Put things back so that the forest stays tidy and the animals safe.
- 9. Be kind to each other, share and take turns.

- 3. Sit down on the log seats.
- 4. Leave all sticks outside.
- 5. No throwing or swinging things around. They may hurt someone.

- 8. Tell the grown ups about your day. They are always interested.
- 9. Wash or wipe your hands before eating.
- 10. Don't put fingers in your mouth.
